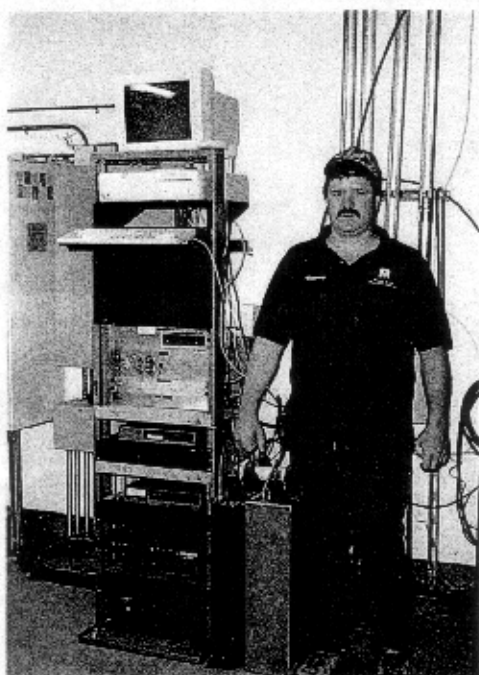
I would like to thank Russ, N7B0 for his great service to the club as Newsletter Editor. We hope to continue to see you at club meetings, Russ.
